Club News

On 13 Jun 2019, Johnny Tolly took brother Jimmy along as his trusty room assistance, AKA Keackler. Johnny did a demonstration for the Hunt County Wood Turners up in Greenville TX. There were about 60 people in attendance. Johnny demonstrated how he makes Beads of courage boxes "BOC" Everyone was encouraged to make BOC boxes for the sick children in their area. Johnny demonstrated his technique of using six inch thin walled PVC pipe, child friendly fabric as he calls it and the use of flat wood stock. Johnny was able to get all points across in making special wooden jaws to trim up the cut PVC, how to cut the PVC pipe, trim both cut ends and glue on the fabric. Johnny then proceeded to demonstrate how to turn a lid, with three separate ways to hold the wood for finial turning and sanding. He then demonstrated how to turn the top and bottoms, cut groves for the PVC with the fabric attached. Johnny then he demonstrated how to reduce the wood for the bottom and top which makes the BOC box lighter for

sick children to carry. Sanding was discussed though not a lot of sanding was performed to save time so Johnny could demonstrate how to turn the lids top knob, how to cut the BOC beads in half then how to assemble all parts into a completed Beads of Courage box.




