Called Board Meeting Minutes from 9/8/2020

Board President Vaden Mohrmann called a special board

Vaden called the meeting to order shortly after 7:00 PM on Tuesday, September 8, 2020.

In attendance were Vaden Mohrmann, President, Joseph Schoenfield, Vice president, Pat Jenkins, Secretary, Len Brissette, Treasurer and Drew Shelton, at large.

The first item of business was to put the board president on the checking account. Len stated the bank requires the president and the treasurer to be on the account. Pat Jenkins made a motion to place the president of the board of directors of CTWA on the checking account.

Joseph Schoenfield seconded the motion.

Vaden asked for all in favor to affirm and affirmation was unanimous.

The second item of business was the election on officers for 2021.

Discussion was that there were only two physical business meetings held this year because of the state local restrictions. All other meetings have been Zoom meetings. The President and President Elect had no chance to accomplish any goals or carry out the duties of their respective offices. Both stated they would take the same position next year if possible. Len made a motion to carry our present slate of officers over to next year seconded by Drew. All officers will be contacted to determine whether they would continue at their position next year. If all agree the 2021 election will be brought before the membership as one item. If an officer wants out that position will be filled separately.

Vaden asked for all in favor to affirm and affirmation was unanimous.

Vaden will ask Gary Beers, Club President, to contact the officers for their willingness to serve before our next Zoom business meeting.

Treasurer Len Brissette stated that CTWA currently has \$10,756.29 on deposit and we have no outstanding debts. He stated our month demo is costing between \$250.00 and \$350.00 per month and we have had no other expenses.

Vaden reminded that we are required to present and approve an annual budget, and Len said he would have one for consideration for 2021.

There was a brief discussion of raising money for the club by auctioning tools or supplies that could be obtained from vendors. Ideas to be discussed with the officers.

We briefly discussed the Christmas party and all feel that we may not have one this year unless things make a very positive change.

Having concluded all the items to be discussed Vaden made a motion that the meeting adjourn. Joseph Schoenfield seconded and we adjourned about 7:50.


