The July monthly meeting of the Central Texas Woodturner's Association was called to order by President Gary Beers at 7:12 pm on Tuesday, July 17, 2023 at the American YouthWorks facility.

Minutes for the June 2023 meeting were approved.

Recognized visitors/new members were Mrs. Bob Duncan and Ashley Carr.

SWAT – Marcia Tolly discussed the need for volunteers to help set-up the Waco Convention Center on Thursday, August 24th and to take-down on Sunday, August 27th after the demonstrations. Let Marcia know if you can assist on either day. CTWA needs

volunteers to host the room we sponsor and to operate the AV equipment. Cortland Hunt stated that Room 207 can be set-up in either horizontal or vertical format.


